



Wolston Millennium Millstone

“A special landmark... a tangible link with the Wolston of the past”

In 1999, a pair of heavy Millstones were recovered from the woods near the old Wolston Mill. Several villagers had suggested that the stones should be used as a feature on the bank of The Brook, that would act as a link with the village of the past and the village of the new Millennium.

Unfortunately one of the stones disintegrated before it could be used, but the remaining stone was safely installed in August 2000.

Mrs Kathleen Holloway, the oldest Wolstonian at the time, and Mackenzie Newman, the youngest child on the school roll, unveiled the Millstone and plaque on Saturday 30th September 2000, during a special ceremony to mark the event.
